Studied Economics at the London School of Economics of the University of London, specializing in Monetary Economics. She graduated in 1976, having been awarded the degree of Bachelor of Science (B.Sc).

In 1977 she graduated from the Business School of the City University of London, having been awarded the degree of Master of Science (M.Sc) in Business Administration.

In 1978 she was employed by the Ministry of Finance of the Republic of Cyprus, where she worked in various positions, mainly in the Division of Finance and Investments. As Senior Officer in this Division she was responsible for the co-ordination of the financing of the big Government development projects from international organizations, as well as for the financing of the Government from foreign credit institutions.

In 1999 she was appointed by the Council of Ministers as Superintendent of Insurance. Since then she is the head of the Insurance Companies Control Service and is the competent supervisory authority of the insurance sector in Cyprus, responsible for the implementation of the Insurance Services and Other Related Issues Laws.
