Ms Anneli Tuominen



Anneli Tuominen is Director General of the Financial Supervisory Authority in Finland (FIN-FSA), an integrated authority supervising the banking, insurance and securities sectors in Finland. The authority is responsible also for the macro-prudential supervision in Finland. She has served as Director General since February, 2007. She joined the FIN-FSA already in 1996 and acted as Deputy Director General in charge of the Capital Markets Department.

Prior to joining the FIN-FSA Ms Tuominen worked in the private sector.

Ms Tuominen is a voting member of the ECB Supervisory Board of the Single Supervisory Mechanism (SSM). She is also a voting member in EBA (European Banking Authority), EIOPA (European Insurance and Occupational Pensions Authority) and ESMA (European Securities and Markets Authority) and a non-voting member in the ESRB (European Systemic Risk Board).

Ms Tuominen is Vice-Chair of ESMA. She is also chairing the Consumer Protection and Financial Innovation Sub-Committee of the Joint Committee. In Finland she is a board member of the Finnish Financial Ombudsman Bureau.

Previously she chaired the Financial Innovation Standing Committee of ESMA for two terms (ended autumn 2015).

Ms Tuominen holds a master's degree in law (trained on the bench) and is also a bachelor of economic sciences.
