



Frédéric HERVO, has been Director for International Affairs of the French *Autorité de contrôle prudentiel et de résolution* (ACPR) since June 2016. The directorate for International Affairs is in charge of preparing the policy of ACPR in the area of prudential regulation and accounting issues for banks and insurers, as well as contributing to the implementation of international and European standards at national level.

Frédéric HERVO is a member of the Policy Development Group of the Basel Committee on Banking Supervision (BCBS), of the Policy Development Committee of the International Association of Insurance Supervisors (IAIS) and of the Compensation Monitoring Contact Group of the Financial Stability Board (FSB). He is also the ACPRs' alternate member to the Board of Supervisors of the European Insurance and Occupational Pensions Authority (EIOPA).

He was previously Director of the Payment Systems and Market Infrastructures directorate of Bank of France from 2012 to 2016 and held several positions at Bank of France for which he has been working since 1992.
