

David Rule was appointed Executive Director, Insurance Supervision at the Bank of England from 1 July 2016. Prior to this he was Executive Director of Prudential Policy, leading on Banking and Insurance policy.

David joined the FSA in 2009 as the Head of the Macro Prudential Department, moving to UK banking supervision in 2011 and subsequently being appointed Director, International UK Banks in 2012. Prior to his time at the FCA David was Chief Executive of the International Securities Lending Association, a trade body representing participants in the European securities financing market. From 1990 to 2006 David worked at the Bank of England in a number of roles, including market infrastructure, financial stability analysis and banking supervision. From 2002 to 2006 he was Head of Sterling Markets Division at the Bank.

David has a degree in Modern History from Balliol College Oxford and further degrees in Political Science from the University of Toronto and Economics from Queens' College
