I have a PhD in Economics and Actuarial Science. I am a professor in the Department of Economic, Financial and Actuarial Mathematics of the University of Barcelona. I lead investigator of the Actuarial and Financial Modelling Research Group and President of the Scientific Committee of the Observatory of European Complementary Social Pension Plans.

My doctoral thesis “Control dinámico-estocástico de la solvencia de los planes de pensiones” (1992) was my first work on pensions. After that, I published several papers on this topic that I have presented into International congresses.

I have published more than 100 scientific publications, including numerous articles in journals with JCR. Many of the articles are in collaboration with internationally well-known foreign researchers. I maintain active collaborations with national and international research groups focused on pensions, insurance and operational research.

I have presented more than 80 works at national and international congresses and participated and organised scientific committees of various national and international congresses: i.e. First European Seminar on Private Pensions (June 2023) and Workshop on Pensions and Insurance (annual edition, since 2015).

I have directed several doctoral theses and research projects in doctoral and university master's programmes.

I have been coordinator of the Doctorate in Business at the University of Barcelona, general coordinator of the Doctorate in Business Studies at the University of Barcelona and coordinator of the Master in Research in Business, Finance and Insurance also at the same university.
