I have been working at Munich Re since 2015 as Chief Actuary in Life and Health Reinsurance, responsible for the markets in Europe and the Middle East. In this role, I am currently responsible for pricing and business development, but in the past my responsibilities have shifted and I have also held positions in risk management, finance and reporting, structured reinsurance, data management and data science. Prior to that, I was Chief Risk Officer at Swiss Life from 2011 to 2015, first for the Swiss market and later for the German market. From 2001 to 2011, I held various positions in actuarial, risk management and product development at ERGO and Munich Re.

As an active member of the German Actuarial Association (DAV), I am a board member and chair of the Enterprise Risk Management Committee. Prior to that, I held various positions in life and risk management working groups and was an active trainer for the CERA programme. In the Actuarial Association of Europe (AAE), I am a board member and have previously served as vice chair of the Risk Management Committee and chair of the Sustainability and Climate Risks Working Group.

Already during the Solvency II review, I played an important role for the DAV and the AAE in responding to EIOPA's consultations. This continued in the subsequent consultations on IRRD and sustainability. I strongly believe in the independent role of actuaries as risk advisors and advocates for informed decisions within companies and also in the regulatory environment. I am very pleased to act as such in this stakeholder group.
