Evelyne Massé is an actuary and graduated from École polytechnique and ENSAE (Master in economics and statistics). She has devoted most of her career to financial supervision, since 2001, both in terms of policy and supervisory practice, on-site and off-site. She started with insurance, before moving to the banking sector in 2018 and engaging actively in the Single Supervisory Mechanism.

She has also spent three years at the European Commission (2006-2009), where she contributed to the drafting and adoption of the Solvency II Directive.

She has occupied various managing positions at the ACPR since she came back from Brussels end 2009 (from Head of Unit, up to Director), before being nominated Deputy secretary general in charge of the banking sector in March 2023. Since then, she also sits on the Board on the French Accounting Standards Authority.

Nominated as First deputy secretary general from 1st September 2024, she will oversee the insurance supervision in France and be the ACPR representative at EIOPA's Board of supervisors.
