Pierpaolo Marano is a tenured Professor of Insurance law and regulation at the Catholic University of the Sacred Heart - Milan. Professor Marano holds a Ph.D. in Banking law and regulation from the University of Siena and he is a scholar in residence at the University of Connecticut, School of law – Insurance Law Center, an Honorary Fellow at the University of Hong Kong – Asian Institute of International Financial Law and an Affiliate Faculty at the Department of Insurance of the University of Malta.

A widely sought writer and speaker on insurance law and regulation and one of the drafters of the Italian Code of Private Insurance, he is the author of two monographs, co-editor of six books and author of around 100 academic papers on insurance law and regulation, corporate law, banking law and bankruptcy law.

He currently sits on the executive committee of AIDA Europe and chairs the Working party on the Distribution of Insurance Products. Moreover, Prof. Marano chairs the Scientific Committee of AIDA Europe and he is the Director of the AIDA Europe Research Studies on Insurance Law and Regulation. He is serving as an associate editor of the European Insurance Law Review.
