Having served diligently as a representative of Academia within the Occupational Pension Stakeholder group for the past four years, I am eager for the opportunity to continue contributing to the group's endeavours for another term.

During my PhD studies, I conducted research on occupational pension schemes and the harmonization of solutions for migrant workers. The outcome of these studies was the book "Occupational Pension Schemes in the EU" (2016). I possess extensive knowledge of legislation concerning occupational pension schemes across the EU and how they operate in practice. In my research at the Warsaw School of Economics, I focus primarily on occupational pension schemes, accessibility of retirement schemes, and pension funds' investments, especially in the context of sustainable investments.

I have provided expert input to various EU councils and groups, including networks of independent experts in the field of intra-EU professional mobility, e.g., for trESS (Training and Reporting on European Social Security) and FreSsco (Free Movement of Workers and Social Security Coordination). Additionally, I conduct research and collaborate with the University of Liverpool, Hertie School in Berlin, and Oxford University.

I actively collaborated with EIOPA on various initiatives beyond the scope of the OPSG. This included conducting research and contributing to the report on "Consumer testing on financial product disclosures for environmentally sustainable investments in pre-contractual and periodic disclosures under the Taxonomy Regulation." This collaboration underscores my commitment to supporting EIOPA's efforts and advancing the objectives of sustainable investments within the pension sector.

I regularly publish in national and international peer-reviewed journals on retirement insurance and ESG investments. My research interests also include issues related to gender equality in the pension system, both public and private, including occupational pensions.
