LATEST DEVELOPMENTS

Consolidated Guidelines

- In the context of the regular review of the Implementing Technical Standards (ITSs) on reporting and disclosure, the Guidelines on Financial Stability (FS) reporting have been amended via errata publications
- ▶ EIOPA will publish a consolidated version of Guidelines on Financial Stability (FS) reporting that encompasses:
 - All past amendments and corrections covered in the published Erratas
 - Clarifications on aspects of the reporting for several FS templates, that came apparent via the Q&A process
- ▶ The consolidated version will be accompanied with its corresponding technical annexes (A and B)
- The publication of the Guidelines is planned for Q1-2024

Reporting of S.38.01.11

- ▶ EIOPA published for the first time the shocked risk-free rates (RFR) for the calculation of the "Option-adjusted" duration to be reported in S.38.01.11 Duration of technical provisions
- The shocked RFR aims to ensure consistent calculation of this duration metric
- EIOPA will update the term structures and publish them twice a year. The next update is coming in July 2024
